During the week prior to the 2006 Census, 820 people aged 15 years and over who were usually resident in Katunga (Suburb) were in the labour force. Of these, 65.7% were employed full-time, 22.7% were employed part-time, 5.6% were employed but away from work, 3.3% were employed but did not state their hours worked and 2.7% were unemployed. There were 249 usual residents aged 15 years and over not in the labour force.
