During the week prior to the 2006 Census, 2,479 people aged 15 years and over who were usually resident in Yarrawonga (Suburb) were in the labour force. Of these, 55.9% were employed full-time, 32.6% were employed part-time, 4.5% were employed but away from work, 2.3% were employed but did not state their hours worked and 4.7% were unemployed. There were 2,235 usual residents aged 15 years and over not in the labour force.
